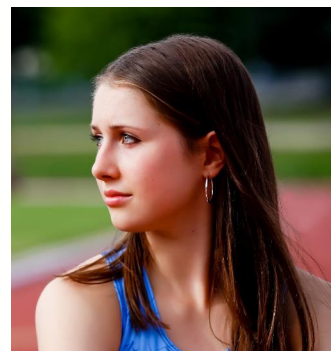


A consumer protection law that aims to provide transparency around campus crime policy and statistics.
