## Digital Badging

We have been beta testing this initiative over the past year and are proud to now roll out badges for all individuals who are actively certified. Read on to learn more about digital badges and how to add and display them properly on your social media accounts and professional signature.

### What is a digital badge?

A digital badge is an electronic representation and verification of a professional accomplishment. Digital badges are a great way to quickly showcase your knowledge and expertise to a broad audience.

### Have you gotten your CCB certification digital badge?

With CCB digital badges you can place your active certification into professional electronic communications such as letterhead, business cards, in directory listings, or in your signature. The best part is digital badges are 100% authenticated by CCB and embedded with qualifying information to verify your certification immediately when viewed by others.

Digital badges are meant to be shared. With digital badging you can easily add your current certification status to your profiles on popular social networking sites like LinkedIn, Twitter, Facebook, and Instagram. Your badge will help to verify your certification status with your current organization, or highlight your achievement and compliance knowledge for a future employer. # How to Properly use my Logo/Badge on LinkedIn

Digital badges protect the integrity of our credential by providing a link to verified data from the issuing organization that cannot be falsified. Their personalized badge URL can be posted to or shared on various social media platforms, link LinkedIn.

1. Click on the “LinkedIn (Quick add URL)” link in the “Access Your Certificate and Digital Badge” Email.
2. This link will auto populate your certification information into the “Add license or certification” fields within LinkedIn. You will want to be logged into LinkedIn prior to this.
3. The link found in the Credential URL field needs to be the link found within your Access Your Digital Badge email for your certification to be verifiable to others.
4. Click Save.
5. Your badge will be added to the LinkedIn Licenses & Certifications section.
6. The logo shown in the Licenses & Certifications section should be the type of certification you hold.
7. To verify a badge, click on the “Show Credential” button. If this button is not there or does not lead to the BadgeCert verification page, then the information seen on LinkedIn cannot and is not verified correctly.

Certified Compliance & Ethics Professional (CCEP)®

The Certified Compliance & Ethics Professional (CCEP)® is someone with knowledge of relevant regulations and expertise in compliance processes sufficient to assist organizations in understanding and addressing legal obligations, and promote organizational integrity through the operation of effective compliance programs.

The CCEP examination was developed through a combined effort of qualified content experts and testing professionals. It tests a well-defined body of knowledge representative of professional practice in the discipline. Content experts and testing professionals review test items to ensure they are accurate in content, relevant to practice, and representative of good testing procedures.

The CCEP is an actively held certification. Only those individuals who meet the eligibility requirements and successfully pass the examination attain the two-year CCEP designation. Only these individuals may use the logo and gain access to the digital badging offerings as long as their certifications are maintained and kept in "active" standing.

The CCEP certification program is managed by the Compliance Certification Board (CCB)®, established in 1999. CCB certifies compliance professionals through its seven compliance certification programs. CCB's mission is to develop criteria for the determination of competence in the practice of compliance at a variety of levels, and to recognize individuals meeting these criteria.

Once you have properly added your logo/badge to your LinkedIn profile, employers can verify your certification by clicking on the Show Credential link. This link will take them to the BadgeCert verification page showing your certification. If this link is not on your profile or does not lead to the BadgeCert page, then the information seen on your LinkedIn profile is not properly verified. You can issue your verified link out to current and/or future employers for instant verification of your certification as well as to access your digital copy of your certificate. CCB will also utilize these verified links moving forward for the purposes of certification verification.
